Karen shares her reflections on each stage of the often emotional roller coaster of this journey. At times, Zach's father and brother add their memories. Copies of writing samples, achievement tests, letters, awards, and photographs are included.

Many Stories, Voices of Others is an eye-opening reminder that gifted and talented individuals with dyslexia are far more common in our society than we often realize. Their voices are a mix of heartrending, forceful, weary, and triumphant. Some voices are well-known; most are not. Bright individuals with learning differences, their parents, teachers, and researchers have their say on numerous topics from Identification: A Puzzling Discovery to Higher Education and the Work Force.

The final section **HELP** provides information and advice for parents, teachers, and students. It includes the importance of focusing on strengths, tips for reading comprehension, lists of possible accommodations, types of assistive technology, tactics for choosing a college, and much more. The book concludes with specifics on identification, laws, and resources.

Students with dyslexia and gifts or talents, their parents, and their teachers can all benefit from this insightful work.
